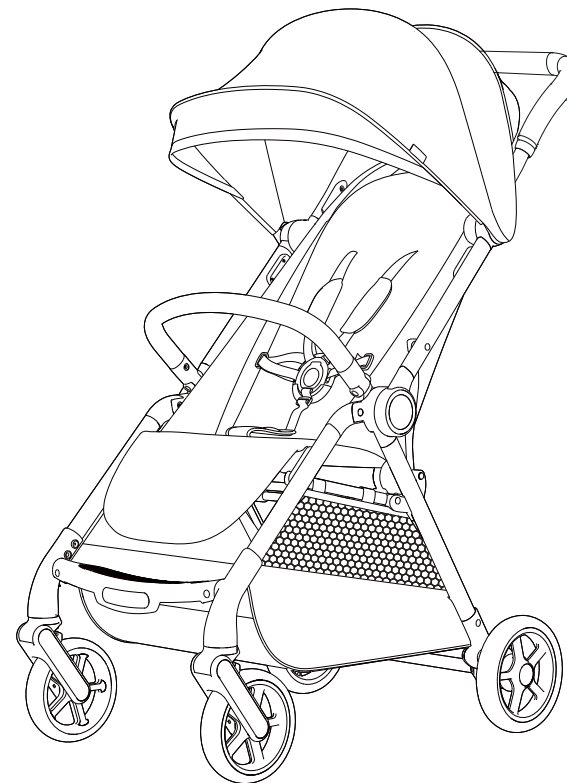

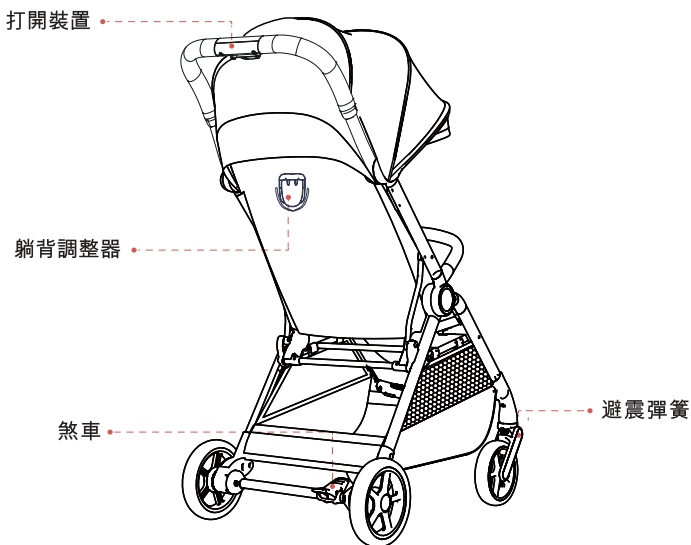
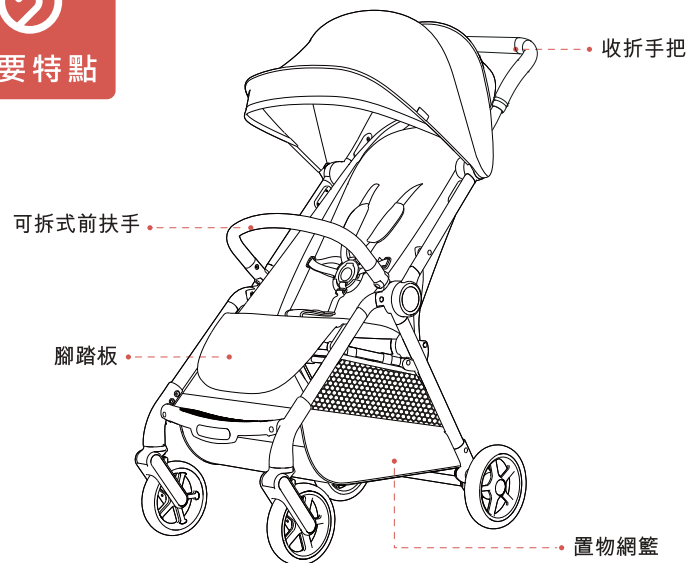


注意事項

1. 使用前請務必先閱讀說明書並了解使用方式。
2. **警告：**錯誤的組裝、收折及使用不正確都有可能造成推車的損壞及影響安全性。請勿超載，盡量將物品放在網籃中間。
3. 請勿讓孩童將推車當作玩具。
4. 使用前，請確認每個功能都可正常操作。
5. 收折推車時，請讓孩童遠離推車。
6. 此推車僅可承載一個小孩，請勿承載超過一個以上的孩子以避免危險。
7. 使用前請確認所有鎖定裝置已定位。
8. 若發現推車上的零配件有損壞，請暫時不要使用。
9. **警告：**請勿在樓梯、台階、扶梯上使用推車，可能會造成危險。
10. **警告：**此推車不適合溜冰或是跑步。
11. **警告：**小孩乘坐推車時，請勿搬動或抬舉推車，以免造成危險。
12. 當處於靜止狀態時，請務必使用煞車。
13. 推車本身無法取代睡箱或是床，如果孩子需要睡覺，請將他放在床上或是睡箱內。
14. 推車箱內的包材或是塑膠袋，請立即丟棄，以免嬰幼兒誤食。
15. 請把塑膠袋遠離嬰幼兒，以免噎食。
16. 推車請遠離火源。
17. 置物網籃最大承載重量7公斤。
18. 推車最大承載重量為15公斤。
19. 適用年齡：新生兒至36個月。
20. 建議新生兒只適用於最平躺角度，6個月以後再調整斜躺角度。
21. 請勿使用非原廠的零配件避免危險，組裝推車須由成人組裝。
22. **警告：**孩童的安全是您的責任，請勿讓孩童單獨在推車上，無人看管。
23. **警告：**隨時都必須使用五點式安全帶。
24. 本推車已通過歐盟認證：EN1888-2: 2018。

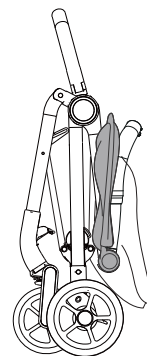

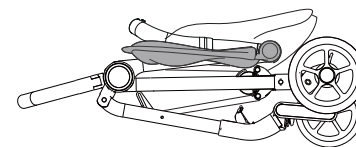
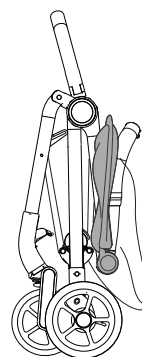
① 收折後可站立



② 收折後可提著前扶手或是拉行著走



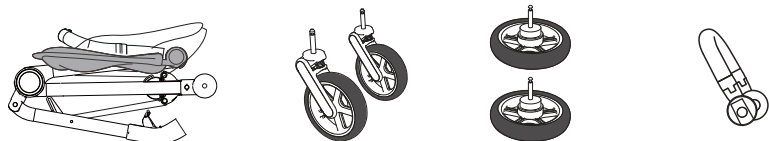

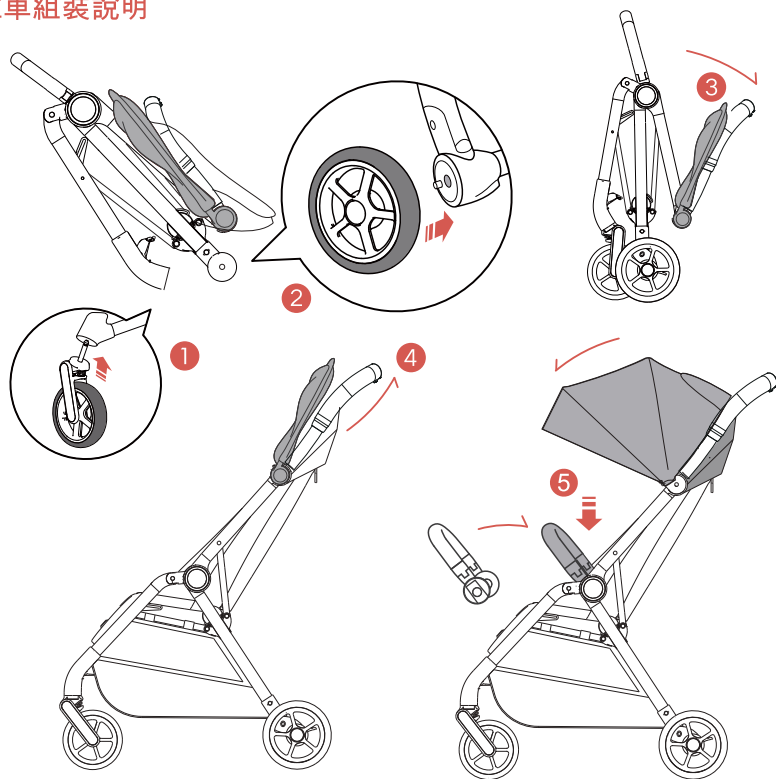
若不使用推車時，請將推車收車並存放如圖

- ① 車架組 (含座椅) ② 前輪 (2個) ③ 後輪 (2個) ④ 前扶手 (1個)

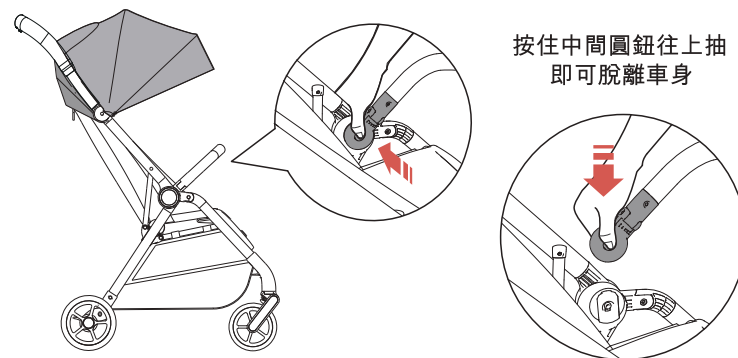


推車組裝說明

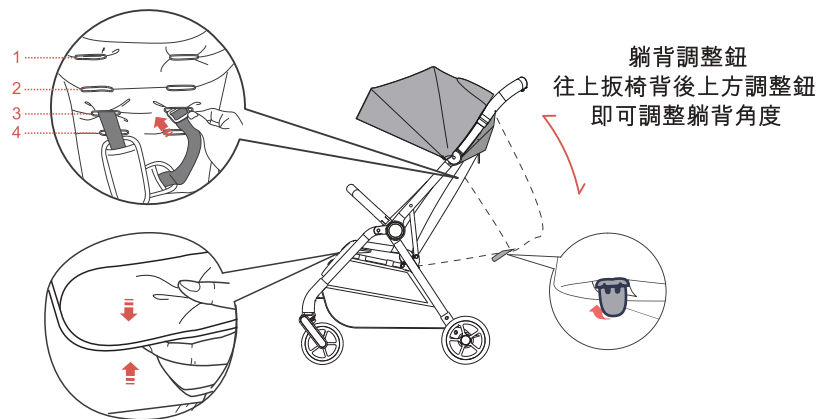


- ① 先將前輪分別插入車架前方兩邊孔位，直到卡至定位。② 將後輪分別插入車架後方兩邊孔位，直到卡至定位。③④ 將把手往上拉起直到推車完全展開至定位。⑤ 將前扶手卡進推車兩側前扶手插孔內。

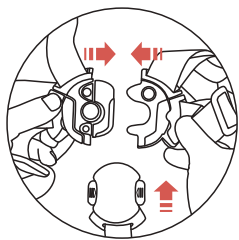

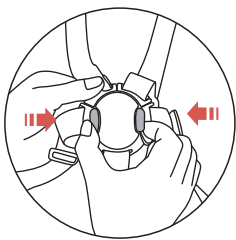


- 腳踏板調整鈕

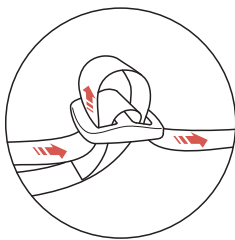

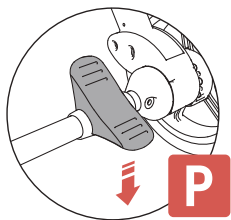

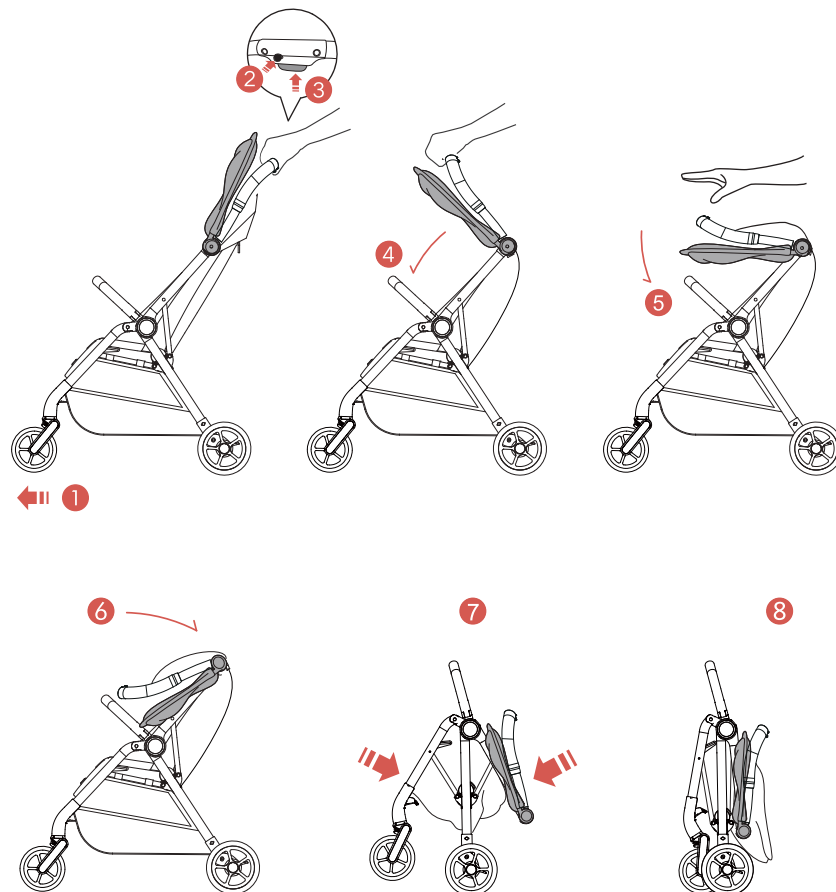


使用煞車：將後輪煞車踏板往下踩

推車收折方式



① 先將推車前輪朝向前方。②③ 先按下把手上方小鈕，再按下把手中間按鈕。④⑤ 順勢將推車往前，並放開推車把手。⑥ 把手落下至前扶手處。⑦ 後輪及前輪會隨把手落下的同時往內收折。⑧ 推車自動收折完成。

保養及維修

- 定期檢查您的推車，是否功能都正常使用。
- 若您的推車有所受損，請與購買的 hybrid premium 經銷商聯絡，進行後續售後維修。
- 建議不要讓推車長時間曝曬在陽光下，正常的戶外使用，也有可能造成布料上的顏色變化。
- 請確認拉鍊已完全拉開或是拉上。
- 大晴天請勿使用雨罩。
- 請勿在遮陽篷上方放置物品，以免造成遮陽篷的損害。
- 輪胎可能在某些地面上留下痕跡，推車不用時，請收折起來。
- 定期的保養檢查才能使推車功能穩定，若是遇到推車無法收折或是難以收折的情況，請勿強行收折，請與購買的經銷商聯絡。
- 輪胎保養：可用濕布擦拭輪子，再用軟乾布擦乾。若您聽到推車發出異音，可以自行先上點潤滑油，或是向原購買經銷商洽詢。
- 清潔座布：請依座布上清洗標示做清潔，建議手洗，請勿乾洗、漂白、烘乾、熨燙。
- 拆裝座布前，請記得每個部位扣住的順序，方便之後裝回去的程序。

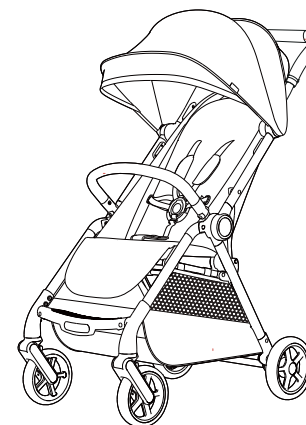
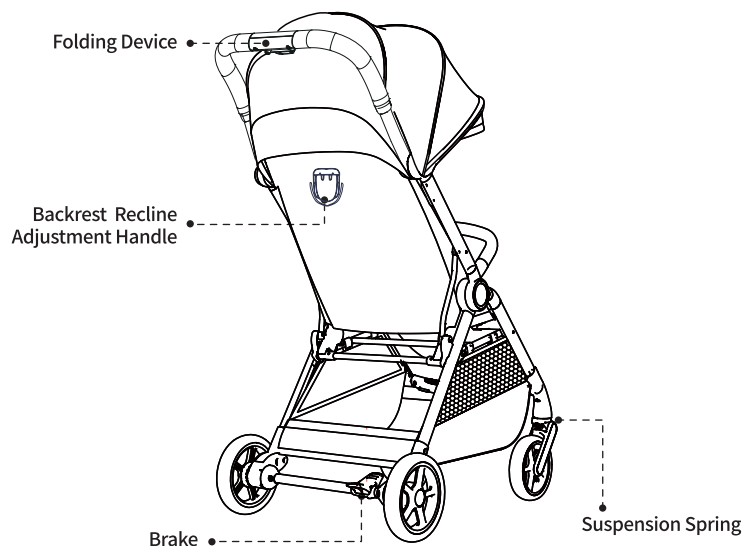
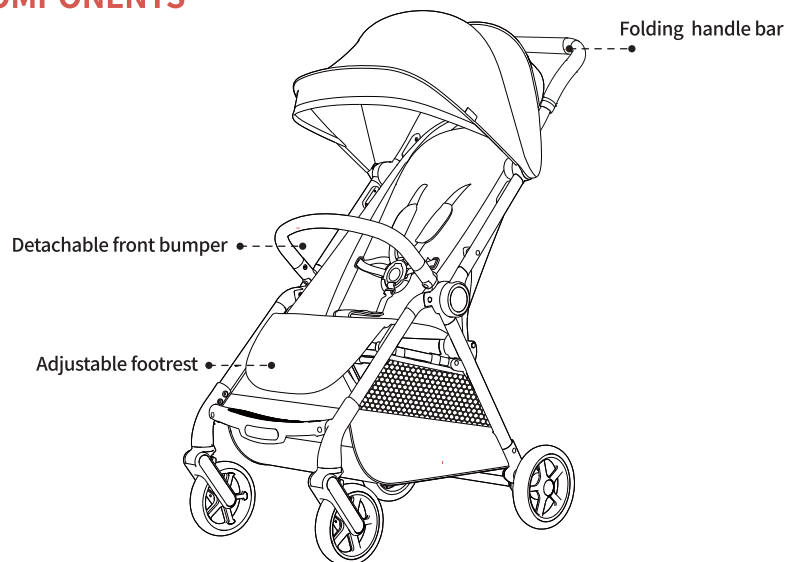
WARRANTY

- A stroller has many moving parts and requires regular maintenance by the user.
- Simple cleaning and lubricating will make the stroller look good & operate better for longer.
- The stroller will be used in many different environments, country walks, a trip to the coast; a winter's walk to school, all can increase wear, lead to rust and corrosion and reduce the life of the product.
- Regular cleaning, care and maintenance will reduce the effects of the environment on the stroller.
- The warranty does not protect the stroller against overloading, misuse, neglect or lack of care and maintenance by the user.
- Our company provides a warranty in support of the retailer from whom you purchased this product. The warranty is effective for 24 months from the date of purchase for the original purchaser/owner.
- Proof of purchase will be required in order for your retailer to claim on the warranty.
- The warranty excludes any fault caused by misuse, damage or neglect.
- It is the user's responsibility to undertake routine inspection and maintenance of the vehicle in order to avoid damage to the vehicle and/or injury to the child.
- The vehicle is returned to the retailer at the owner's expense in order to ascertain if a claim under the warranty is justified.
- Please carefully read the instructions on how to look after your stroller. This does not affect your statutory rights.

WARNING

1. Do not leave stroller unattended with child inside.
2. Do not lift stroller with child inside.
3. Do not allow child to stand in stroller.
4. Do not adjust backrest with child inside.
5. Do not let children play with this product.
6. Do not leave child in the stroller while ascending or descending stairs or escalators or when traveling on other forms of transport.
7. Do not hang bags or put items on handle bar as they may affect stability of the stroller.
8. Children must use safety belt or restraint system at all times.
9. This product is not suitable for running or skating.
10. This product is not intended for prolonged period of children sleeping.
11. To avoid injury ensure that the child is kept away when unfolding and folding this product.
12. The brake shall be engaged when placing and removing the child from the stroller.
13. Ensure all braking devices are used before stopping stroller.
14. Ensure all locking devices are locked before using stroller.
15. Ensure children are clear of the stroller when using movable accessories.
16. Never carry more than one child per seat.
17. Stroller may be damaged and children injured if overloaded or folded incorrectly.
18. Keep stroller away from fire.
19. Read the instructions carefully before use to avoid harm. Keep manual for future reference.
20. Keep plastic parts away from children and immediately dispose of any plastic bags and packaging to prevent suffocation of babies and children.
21. This product is suitable for children not exceeding 22kgs in weight or 48 months old, whichever comes first.
22. This stroller is unfit for 0 to 6 months old children when backrest is less than 150 degrees.
23. Always use the most reclined position when used the stroller for new born babies.
24. Articles in basket should not exceed 3kgs in weight.
25. This product cannot use any accessories or spare parts as replacement supplied other than our authorized dealer or supplier. It needs to be assembled by adults.
26. Executive standard : EN1888-2:2018.

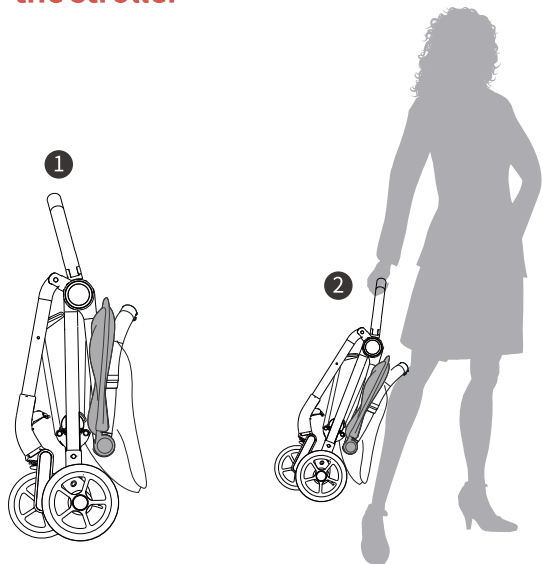

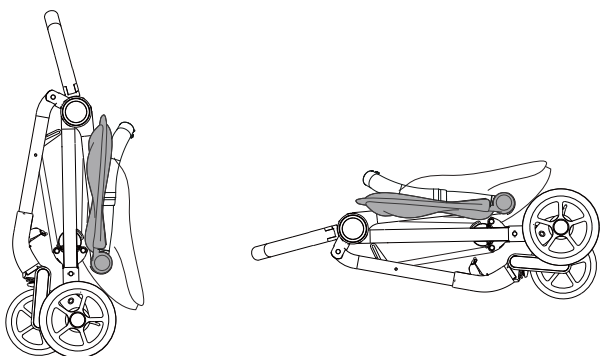
CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Check screws, rivets and other fixed parts periodically and replace defectiver or loose parts to ensure stability and safety. It is important to clean and dry the stroller thoroughly after use in winter, beach, countryside, rain and othe vulnerable conditions.
- Check all locking devices regularly to see if they work properly.
- If any part of the pushchair is damaged contact our company retailer immediately without using the pushchair.
- Do not leave stroller under intense sunlight for an extended period of time. The fabric will fade normally during use when exposed to ultraviolet light.
- Do not tear the fabric when move the stroller.
- Low viscosity or lubricating oil can be used on movable parts.
- Vaseline is a good lubricant for front axle 8. Do not machine wash stroller, instead use a sponge, a cleaner and warm water.
- Ensure that zips are either fully open or fully closed otherwise they get damaged.
- Always use the rain cover in inclement weather.
- Do not place items on the hood/canopy, it may damage the vehicle and/or render it unsafe.
- Rubber tyres can leave marks on some surfaces. They tyres can react with some surfaces (vinyl floor coverings, carpet etc.) and cause stains. Always stand the stroller on a protective surface indoors.
- Fabrics should be cleaned following the guidance on the care labels.

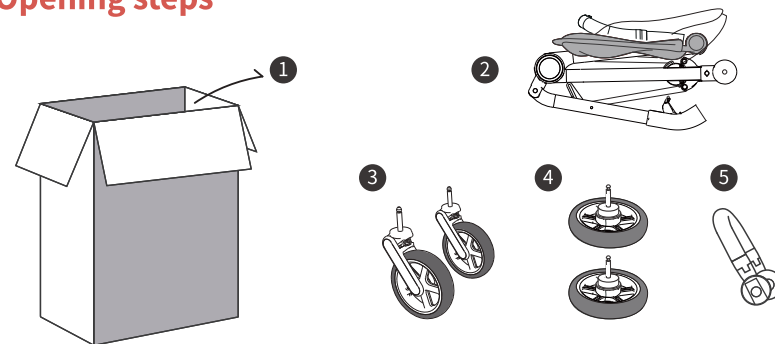

Please fold the stroller when not in use, so the function of the auto folding will be better maintained.

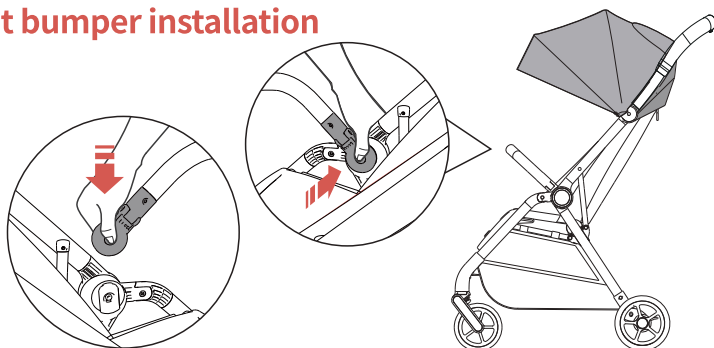

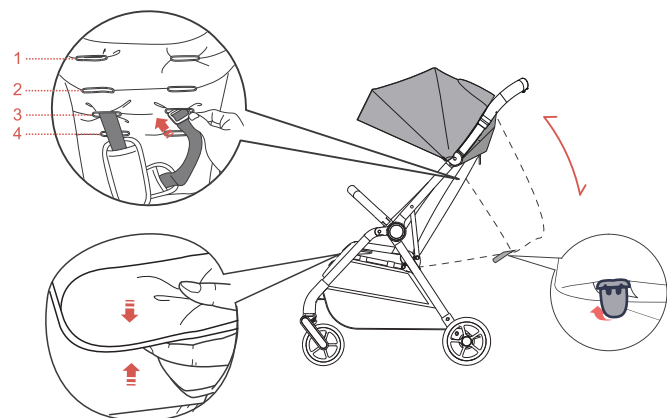
1 Open carton 2 Remove frame 3 Front wheel 4 Rear wheel 5 Bumper bar



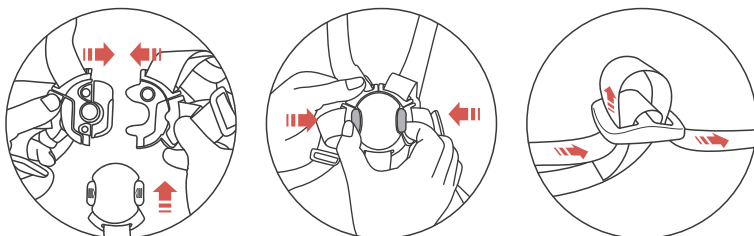
Front bumper installation

Safety belt adjustment

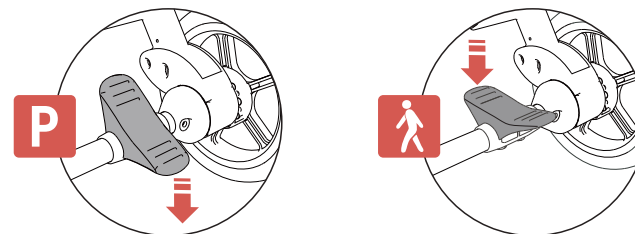
